

Admin, responsibility for maintenance of boundary walls, fences, gates, main paths*, site insurance, water supply (*although paths have not been maintained by BCC for several years)

SWCF Receives 37.1%

To cover staff costs for admin, collecting annual rents, managing plot letting, plus electricity bill for garages

AVAA and volunteers Receives 4.3%

To fund maintenance activities including compost loo, fixing paths, laying & maintaining hedges, adjusting gates, maintaining garages and yard, recovering derelict plots, clearing waste, fixing apple press, fixing taps, controlling overgrown trees & shrubs; as well as representing plotholders, setting up workshop & buying tools, plus running annual show & other events.
